'...the punishment...' ... '...the punishment...' 'Those whose scales are heavy shall triumph, but those whose scales are light shall forfeit their souls and abide in Hell for ever. Its flames will scorch their faces and they will writhe with pain.' Page 220 of the Penguin Koran.

Next page you are brought some relief: 'Say: "Lord, forgive and have mercy: You are the best of those that show mercy."' Remember, 'Allah is the Compassionate, the Merciful'. It is interesting to note in that quote Allah is again referred to as one of a group; '*the best that show mercy.*' Judging from what we have read so far, and from the overt actions of Muslims; especially the extremely chimpified ones, if Allah is the best of a group of merciful beings, I have a very hard time imagining how much more horrible those others are. What's your take on that? If you've been keeping up with Down the Rabbit Hole, you have read before where Allah is referred to as one of a group. Perhaps seven Koran Scholars can clarify that for us.

Page 221 starts a new chapter titled: TA HA 'In the Name of Allah, the Compassionate, the Merciful. *A ba. (?)** It was not to distress you that We revealed the Koran, but to admonish the God-fearing. It is a revelation from Him who has created the earth and the lofty heavens, the Merciful who sits enthroned on high.' *The translator has no idea.

Page 222: 'I am Allah. There is no god but Me. Serve Me, and recite your prayers in My remembrance.'

Reciting prayers is not praying. Speaking formulas is not how I talk with My Father in Heaven. We talk, we don't recite scriptures to each other. Muslims recite prayers, like incantations; the men all together in a group and the women in another group, separate and apart, all of them enveloped in Islamic love and harmony, creating a kind of hypnotic state of mind numbing, which must be done FIVE TIMES per day, every day, every week, every month, every year, after year, after year. When one adds up the amount of time spent in reciting the same incantations, on your knees five times per day, it amounts to a whole lot of time wasted where nothing gets done. Hence, Allah doesn't feel anything when he sees you tortured and

murdered for your thought crime of thinking you are an individual and prefer to contemplate more pleasant things than Doom Days, Hell fires, Scourges, and harrowing punishments.

The chapter, Ta Ha is mostly about Moses, Aaron, and interactions with Pharaoh, who is also the bad guy in the Koran, as he is in the Torah. Remember, Moses killed a man; an Egyptian overseer. Here is how Allah worked things out with old Moe. 'And when you killed a man, We delivered you from affliction and proved you by other trials.' Page 222. Moses murdered and by rights he should have stood a trial in Pharaoh's court. However, as Allah said, 'Go both of you to Pharaoh, for he has transgressed all bounds. Speak to him with gentle words; he may yet take heed and fear Our punishment.' Pg. 223.

Remember, the Egyptians believed in doing good. Ma'aat was their preferred practice. Hence, here again we have proof, as we do abundantly have proof in the Torah that Allah and the god of the Pharisees/Jews is the same type of entity who considers the gentle Gypos to be an enemy. Those were the Egyptians of long ago, before they became Muslims. The people who created the ancient civilization on the Nile delta are not the same people as the modern day Egyptians. 'Do they not see how many generations We have destroyed before them?' ... 'All are waiting: so wait if you will. You shall know who has followed the right path and who has been rightly guided.'
