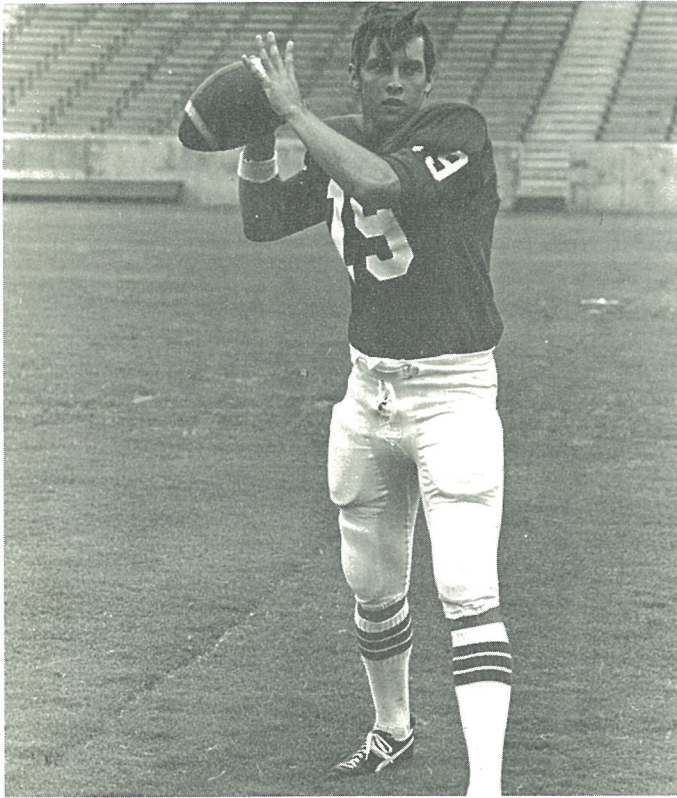

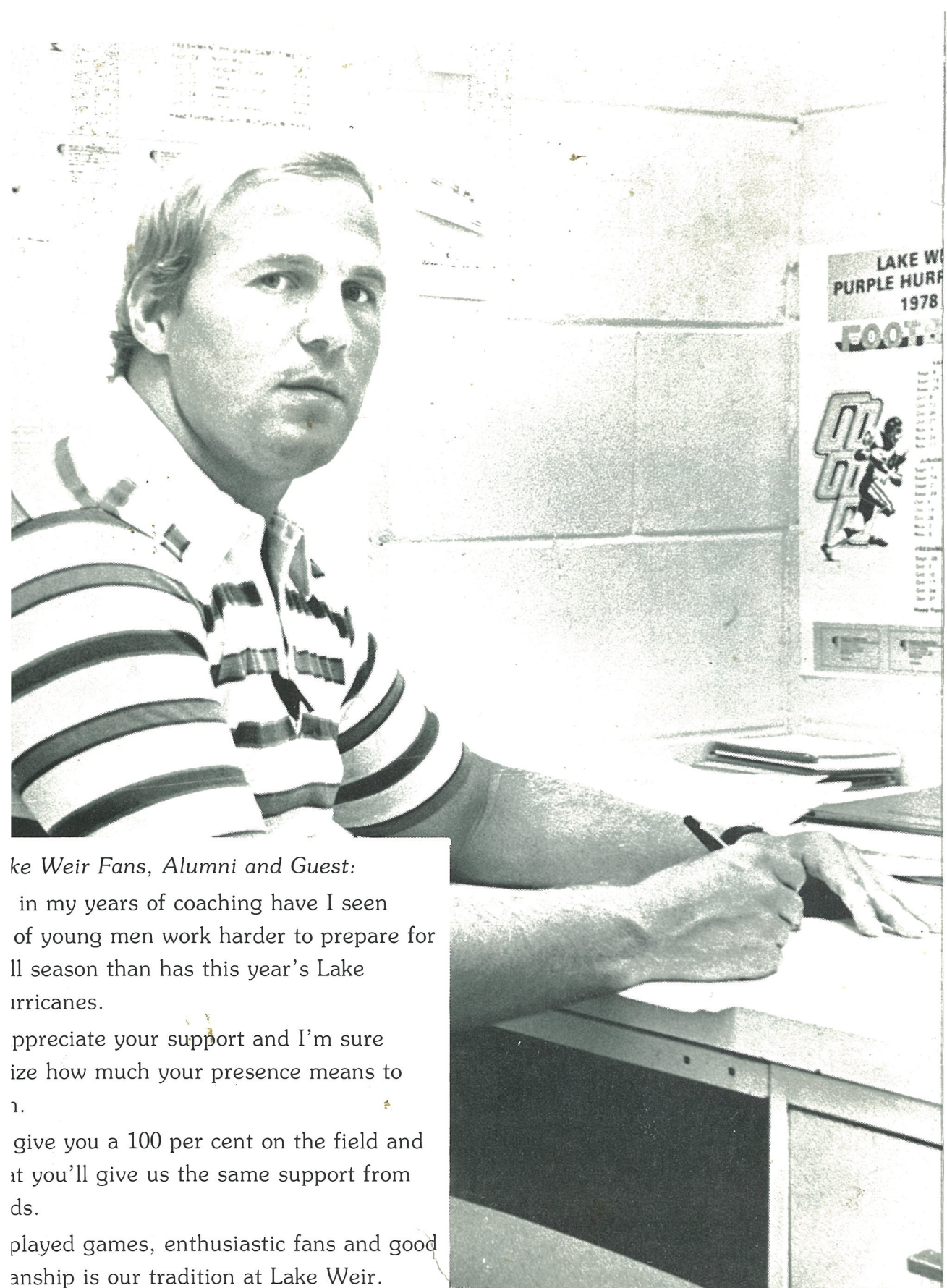

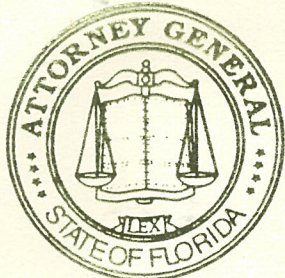

Date December 10, 1966

1. Florida State University agrees to grant to WOLFGANG HALBIG a Grant - In - Aid to attend Florida State University. The scholarship is to consist of: Room, Meals, Tuition, Registration Fees, Books (on loan), and \$15.00 a month for laundry and dry cleaning, beginning January 1, 1967, for Two Years in Football.

2. The above mentioned individual agrees to conform to the regulations and policies relating to students of Florida State University and to participate in the sport in which he accepts the Grant - In - Aid. He must meet the entrance requirements, agree to choose a major and, in each year make normal progress toward a degree, which may be interpreted as a "C" average.

WOLFGANG HALBIG agrees to conform to the regulations of citizenship, scholarship, and athletics set up by the faculty and students of Florida State University and to strive at all times to be a credit to his parents, himself, and the University.

3. In the event of any injury which may cause the above named to forego participation in Intercollegiate Athletics at Florida State University, the Grant - In - Aid will continue to be honored throughout the period covered by the contract.

The 1968 Strategic Air Command Tennis Championships will be held July 14-18 at Vandenberg AFB, Calif. To apply for entry in this tournament call recreation services, ext. 2255 as soon as possible.

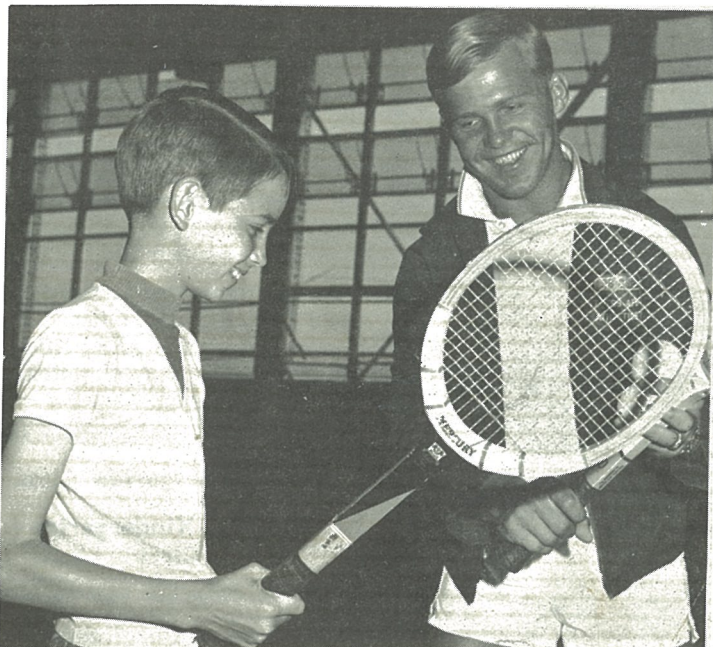
Netmen representing SAC in the USAF Worldwide Tennis Championships will be chosen from among the winners of this tournament.

In open play one singles and one doubles team from each SAC base will participate, except where a base has two players of unusual ability and prior experience in military or civilian tournaments. A total of three players may be entered in the open division competition.

In senior play each base may enter one singles and one doubles team.

A1C Wolfgang Halbig and Mike Rooker represented Dyess in the SAC tournament last year. The two netmen won their first five matches, but were runner-ups after losing to the first place team, Capt. Thomas Young and SSgt. William Foster, from Offutt AFB, Neb., who went on to the USAF Worldwide Tennis Tournament.

Airman Halbig has said that he hopes to represent Dyess again this year. Presently he is teaching dependent youngsters how to play his favorite sport.
