What about those Greeks we spoke of yesterday? 'He (Allah) gives victory to whom He will. He is the Mighty One, the Merciful.' So, he promises the Hour of Doom twice on the next page, and lest you forgot since yesterday and all previous issues of DtRH exploring the Koran, '...those who have disbelieved and denied our revelations and the life to come shall be delivered up for punishment.' Page 189.

Page 190: 'Thus we make plain Our revelations to men of understanding. Indeed the wrongdoers are led unwittingly by their own appetites. And who can guide those whom Allah has led astray? There shall be none to help them. Therefore stand firm in your devotion to the true faith, which Allah Himself has made, and for which He has made man. Allah's creation cannot be changed. This is surely the true religion, although most men do not know it. Turn to Allah and fear Him. Be steadfast in prayer and serve no other god besides Him. Do not split up your religion into sects, each exulting in its own beliefs.'

The preceding is interesting to dissect, so let's get out the literary scalpel and slice and dice those words which Gabriel told Mohammed were from Allah.

Allah refers to himself in the plural: *Our*. The royal *We*, or is it that Allah is more than one being? Maybe the word, Allah refers to an alien group which came and revealed things to those people 1400 years ago. Judging from the alien revelations contained in the Koran; alien in that it is all so very horrible; as if we are reading the literature of Klingons; it is totally the literature of evil beings who are hell bent on torture and slaughter. Note there is no admonishment for believers to go forth and proselytize in the way Christians do it, but to do it with fire and the sword and coerce people into belief in Allah and his revelations. Fear mongering and overt shows of piety, that is Islam.

Note also that Allah again tells you that he is capricious because he can lead you astray and once he does nobody can help you. In the Christian teachings, God does not do that, Satan leads people astray.

Why do human beings, or creatures who resemble human beings insist upon forcing their ideas about God on others?

And, what's with the constant harping on the Day of Doom?
