

After the beginning of the 20th century, streetcars became a popular mode of transportation. In this 1908 photo, some Hollywood residents are about to board a streetcar at the corner of

Sunset Blvd. & Laurel Canyon Blvd. There is a horse and buggy traveling north up Laurel Canyon Blvd.



This photo was taken in 1905 and is looking south, onto Hollywood, from where the Yamashiro Restaurant is located today. The building in the foreground is, today, the headquarters of the American Society of Cinematographers. The building at the top/middle is the first building of Hollywood High School. The building at the left/middle is the first structure of the Hollywood Hotel at Hollywood Blvd. & Highland Ave.





During the 1920's, '30's and '40's movie premiere were some of Hollywood's most popular events. Hundreds of Hollywood residents would line the street, in front of the theater, to watch their favorite "star" arrive to watch the premiering movie. This is the 1944 premiere of "The Sullivans" at Grauman's Chinese Theater.



Hollywood's most popular and famous restaurant was the Brown derby, on Vine St. Many

celebrities would would leave the studios to have a quick bite to eat at the "Derby". Here, in this 1951 photo, are George Burns and Gracie Allen dining at the famous eatery.



One of Hollywood's most famous establishments was Schwab's Pharmacy. Located on Sunset Blvd. & Crescent Heights Blvd. Schwab's catered to many of Hollywood's celebrities. In addition to filling prescriptions, the popular "drugstore" sold all kinds of sundries and had a very large counter where breakfast, lunch and dinner was served. This 1945 photo shows the popularity of the eating counter.
